Course Purpose and Objectives	The purpose of the industrial placement is to familiarize students with the role of staff and principals in the hospitality industry. Students will acquire a practical understanding of the procedures and the skills required within the hospitality departments including kitchen, restaurant, front office, housekeeping procedures, systems and other.
Learning Outcomes	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Demonstrate skills in working in hotel departments which include kitchen, restaurant, front office, housekeeping procedures and systems. 2. Demonstrate work ethical skills as well as their inter-personal and team-working skills. 3. Have an opportunity to become acquainted with principals and professionals in the industry and develop contacts. 4. Gain job experience that can serve as a means for reviewing career goals and career development.
Course Content	The Industrial Training should take place in the Hotel industry during the summer period after the successful completion of the first year of study and provided the student receives 60 ECTS. Under the supervision of the Head of the Field the student is required to complete 12 weeks of training. .
