Course Purpose and Objectives	The course aims to provide students with the basic knowledge and understanding of the Russian language by developing all four skills reading, writing, listening and speaking. Students will be able to communicate in Russian using phrases from daily situations. By the end of the course, the students will be able to give information regarding an object or a person, ask and answer questions, give a description of a person, write small essays and make short dialogues. The course also aims to teach students how to use greetings and phrases in Russian according to Russian culture and the particularities of its people.

Read and understand the Russian alphabet, the articulation of Russian sounds as well as the basic rules in Russian pronunciation.</li> <li>2. Read and understand short texts and dialogues.</li> <li>3. Ask and answer questions based on certain situations from daily life.</li> <li>4. Give information about people and objects by using small phrases.</li> <li>5. Develop communication skills by forming small dialogues based on situations and presenting them in groups of two.</li> </ol>
