Course Purpose and Objectives	The purpose of this course is to provide the advanced knowledge on hotel management methods used to take decisions from a financial point of view. Students will acquire problem solving skills and practice on decision making that is required for a Financial Manager position in the hotel industry. Students will be able to analyse issues related to investment, financing and dividend policy decisions. They will exercise their judgment in taking decisions relating to the financial management of the hotel.

Discuss the impact of the hotel industry economic environment on financial management and the working capital management techniques. Construct effective investment appraisals and evaluate alternative sources of the hotel finance. Explain and calculate the cost of capital and the factors which affect it in hotel industry. Discuss the principles of business and asset valuation and develop risk management techniques for hotel management.
