Course Purpose and Objectives	The purpose of this course is to provide comprehensive knowledge on the general legal framework, and the specific legal areas relating to business. Students will learn the essential elements of agency and the basic principles of contractual agreements including offer, acceptance, consideration, and the intention to create legal relationships. The course also provides an in-depth understanding of company law, covering the formation, regulation and management of companies, in line with professional bodies requirements and introduces students to the law of negligence.
